1. Put key in ignition.
2. Lock all doors.
3. Adjust Seat and Head Restraint.

4. Adjust inside and outside mirrors.
5. Check for loose articles.
6. Fasten safety belt.

Hand Signals

Left Turn Hand Signal



Left hand and arm are extended straight out the window, with hand pointing to the left.

Right Turn Hand Signal



Left hand and arm are extended straight out the window, with hand pointing straight up and with the elbow forming a 90 degree angle.

Stop/Slow Hand Signal



Left hand and arm are extended straight out the window, with hand pointing straight down and with the elbow forming a 90 degree angle.

1. Press down foot-brake.
2. Shift gear selector lever to drive.
3. Release parking brake.
4. Check traffic to rear and sides.

5. Signal when clear.
6. Recheck traffic
7. Move foot to accelerator and press gently.
8. Cancel signal.

Backing Around Corner

If you want the rear end of the car to go to the right, turn the steering wheel to the right. (This is a reverse left turn.)

If you want the rear end of the car to go to the left, turn the steering wheel to the left. (This is a reverse right turn.)

1. Depress brake and shift to reverse.
2. Put both hands near top of steering while turning your head in the direction of backing.
3. Release pressure on brake.

4. Steer in the direction you want the back of the vehicle to travel.
5. Check traffic.
6. Continue to look back until completely stopped.
